- 1. Mas de la Tour, Grenache/Sauvignon, France 2008/2009** €22.50
Vin De Pays
Generously fruity, with plenty of dry, rich acidity. The citrus notes from the sauvignon are balanced perfectly by the grenache producing an easy drinking, fruity and delicious wine!
- 2. Porter Mill Station Chenin Blanc, S. Africa 2008/2009** €23.00
Swartland
This Chenin Blanc is tank fermented at low temperatures to yield a wine which is delicate, dry and aromatic with smooth honeyed citrus fruit, and fresh lingering acidity.
- 3. Pichon Chardonnay, France 2009** €23.50
Vin de Pays des Côtes du Thongue
Smooth and fairly soft on the palate. The rich fruit is balanced by excellent acidity, making this a fresh and quite delicate wine.
- 4. Domaine D'Aubaret, Sauvignon Blanc, France 2009** €25.00
AC Cotes du Roussillon
Lightly refreshing and dry with excellent length boasting tremendous fruit flavours. Perfect with fish or as an aperitif.
- 5. Pinot Grigio, Italy 2009** €25.50
Conte Amato, Sacchetto
Straw yellow in colour with copper reflections with a delicate, light and spicy aroma. Fresh, full-bodied, pleasant with just the right tannic content.
- 6. The Ruins, Chardonnay/Viognier, S. Africa 2010** €26.00
Bon Cap Estate, Robertson Organic
The Chardonnay (86%) with its ripe yellow peachy, apricot and citrus flavours combines with the honey blossom, slightly musky Viognier (14%) to ensure a complete wine, which is rich and full yet remarkably fresh on the palate. Organic winery of the Year SA 2007.

- 7. Domaine des Lauriers, Prestige, France 2009** **€26.00**
AOC Picpoul de Pinet
Glossy appearance with green tints this wine has a young floral nose, a symphony of aromas blending citrus fruit and acacia flowers. Crisp and harmonious on the palate with grapefruit to the fore and the freshness characteristic of this varietal.
- 8. Quando, Sauvignon Blanc, S. Africa 2009** **€29.00**
Fanus Brawer, Robertson
It is light green in colour with exotic forthcoming frangipani flower, passion fruit and gooseberry on the nose. Flinty mineral notes on the palate follow through with a crisp acidity. Wine of the month Irish Times and *****Decanter Magazine 2007.
- 9. Bodegas Pablo Padin, Albarino, Spain 2008** **€32.50**
Raix Baixas, Segrel Amber
The Albarino grape is a hidden gem and is considered to be Spain's best white wine varietal. It is fresh and lively with mellow flavours of peach, apple and citrus fruits with scents of almonds. Complex, rich and ripe, but with the characteristic acidity and expressive flavours to match.
- 10. Gavi di Gavi, Italy, 2009** **€34.00**
Luigi Tacchino, Piedmonte
Bursting with clean, pure fruit and well balanced mineral and lemon oil flavours on the palate. A perfect dry and subtle finish that lingers long and delicately.
- 11. Chablis, France 2007** **€36.00**
Domaine Vrignaud
Working the vineyards with respect to organic practices and handpicking each harvest to make a carefully selected limited production. The result is a traditional Chablis in the best sense: Stylish, minerally and stony, with delicate pear and apple fruit leading to a lasting elegant finish. A lovely match for shellfish.
- 12. Pouilly Fume, France 2008** **€37.00**
Loire Valley, Sequin
A powerful fruity Sauvignon nose is followed through with a zingy and intense fruit on the palate which finishes strong. The wine, which is bottled in March after the harvest, is fruity (aromas of citrus, pink grapefruit and pineapple) and has also the typical "gun flint" flavour which goes remarkably well with seafood, fish with butter sauce, and goat cheese.

- 13. Sancerre, France 2008** **€41.00**
Domaine Sylvain Bailly
A classic Sancerre which reflects its terroir, with driven minerality, intense but elegant herb-sprinkled, lean, green fruit and brisk, perky acidity. Mouth watering and tangy. Decanter magazine wine of the month, March 2010.
- 14. Chablis, 1er Cru Fourchaume, France 2007** **€47.50**
Domaine Vrignaud
AC Chablis is a well respected Premier Cru site. Classic mineral and flinty nose with slight floral scents. A lovely bone-dry wine, nice firm middle-palette with good length. A really fine family estate in Chablis that makes fabulous wine but simply doesn't have the marketing budget to shout its message from the rooftops.

- 15. Black Lagoon Old Bush Vine Shiraz, France 2008** **€22.50**
Vin de Pays d'Oc
Intense deep purple, the full spicy blackberry aromas multiply on the palate with hints of black pepper and integrated subtle tannins, resulting in a long satisfying finish.
- 16. Cuna De Reyes Joven, Spain 2009** **€23.00**
La Rioja
This wine is a blend of 85% Tempranillo and 15% Mazuelo.
Cherry red in colour with
fragrant aromas and fruity blackberry and redcurrant flavours with a nice touch of acidity.
- 17. Porter Mill Station, Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve, S. Africa 2007** **€23.50**
Swartland
Good ripe blackcurrant and soft damson fruit with plenty of balanced oak tones.
Recommended by Decanter Magazine.
- 15. Château La Roca, Shiraz/Grenache, France 2008** **€24.00**
Domaine Bonfils, Cotes du Roussillon
Excellent blend of Shiraz and Grenache producing a wine full of body and character. Highly recommended by Tomas Clancy 'The Sunday Business Post'.

- 19. Rougepeyre Cabardès, France 2007** €25.00
AOC Carcassone
A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Shiraz, Grenache, Côt and Merlot from this new region near Carcassone in the Languedoc. This classic style is well structured, wonderfully rich and smooth with complex fruit flavours and a fine structure.
- 20. Domaine des Lauziers, France, 2006** €26.00
AC Minervois
30% Carignan, 30% Grenache and 40% Syrah aged in French oak. Deep black fruit character with complex perfumed flavours of plums and black cherry. Smooth, yet full bodied, with a robust cinnamon-edged finish.
- 21. Barbera de Monferrato, Italy 2008** €27.50
Luigi Tacchino docg Piedmonte
Bright red in colour and bursting with fruit. Plenty of floral notes both on the nose and palate. Well balanced tannins and acidity lead to a long and big finish.
- 22. Cuna de Reyes Crianza, Spain 2006** €29.00
La Rioja
The wine is a blend of 80% Tempranillo, 15% Garnacha and 5% Mazuelo which is aged for 12 months in American oak casks. Ruby red in colour with garnet hues and hints of ripe fruit and vanilla with a warm smooth finish.
- 23. Lammershoek Zinfandel /Syrah, S. Africa 2006** €35.00
Swartland
Ripe with a chocolatey character to the fruit. It's quite dense and rich with a sweetness to the red and black fruits on the palate. Evolving into an interesting wine, with a bright future ahead of it. Lovely smooth spicy structure.
- 24. Cuna de Reyes Reserva, Spain 2004** €35.50
La Rioja
This wine is a blend of 85% Tempranillo, 10% Mazuelo and 5% Garnacha which is aged for 20 months in American oak casks. Intense cherry red in colour with a round velvety and spicy bouquet.
- 25. Gigondas, France 2006** €36.50
Arnoux et Fils
Ripe plum and raspberry fruit with hints of violets, vanilla and chocolate. Soft tannins and a long finish. A very impressive Gigondas!

- 26. La Fleur Chauvin, France 2006** **€38.00**
AC St Emilion
La Fleur Chauvin is 90% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc, the classic blend in St Emilion, the merlot grape gives the wine an elegance and complexity of fruit, with the Cabernet giving the wine more backbone and length.
- 27. Fleurie, France 2009** **€44.00**
Manoir Du Carra
This Fleurie gets its intense crimson robe, its floral and fruity aromas of iris, violet, rose, red fruit and vine peach from the pink granite soil the vines grow in. The wine has great purity of fruit with ample perfume on both aroma and palate.
- 28. Château Capet-Guillier, France , 2006** **€49.00**
Saint-Émilion Grand Cru
A deliciously ripe and elegant Saint Émilion Grand Cru, showing richness and balance of fruit and all the elegance of the merlot grape in a good year. The wine has good length and minerality on the palate and an excellent partner for both white and red meats.
- 29. Châteauneuf du Pape, France 2007** **€52.00**
Arnoux et Fils
Complex, full flavoured, spicy, red berry fruit with elegant silky tannins and hints of underwood and animal leather. Rich and long finish.
- 30. L'Hospitalet de Gazin France, 2004** **€70.00**
AC Pomerol
Hospitalet de Gazin presents ripe cherries and plum fruit, delicately spiced. The wine has extraordinary elegance and can be matched with almost all dishes.

31. Pinot Grigio Rosé, Montecelli, Italy, 2008

€25.00

IGT Veneto

Beautiful pink colour with violet hues, this Pinot Grigio rosé has a full yet delicate aroma of delicious fruits. On the palate, the silky texture and balanced acidity create an elegant wine with a clean finish.

32. Baron Fuente Champagne, Brut Tradition, France NV

€71.00

Light yellow in colour with very fine mousse. The bouquet is discreet and elegant with notes of brioche and candied or stewed fruits, with a light honey aroma. The mouth is supple and well balanced.

33. Le Mesnil Grand CRU, France NV

€95.50

Champagne Le Mesnil Grand Cru Blanc de Blancs, NV Classic

100% Chardonnay vines planted in 100% echelle vineyards. This current cuvée is based on the 2001 vintage with reserve wines from 2000.

34. Prosecco, Villa Armellina, Italy NV

€29.00

IGT Veneto, Italy

Pale light yellow colour, with fine perlage. Delicately fruity, slightly aromatic bouquet with hints of flowers among which honey and wild apple scents can be perceived. Well balanced with a light body.

35. Prosecco Spumante, Italy

€36.50

This Prosecco is extra dry, refreshing and delivers an outstanding finish.
